

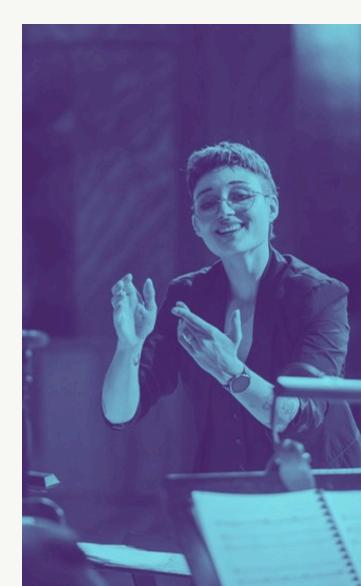


3 BILLIONS HEARTBEATS 876K HOURS OF PASSION 10 YEARS OF MUSIC

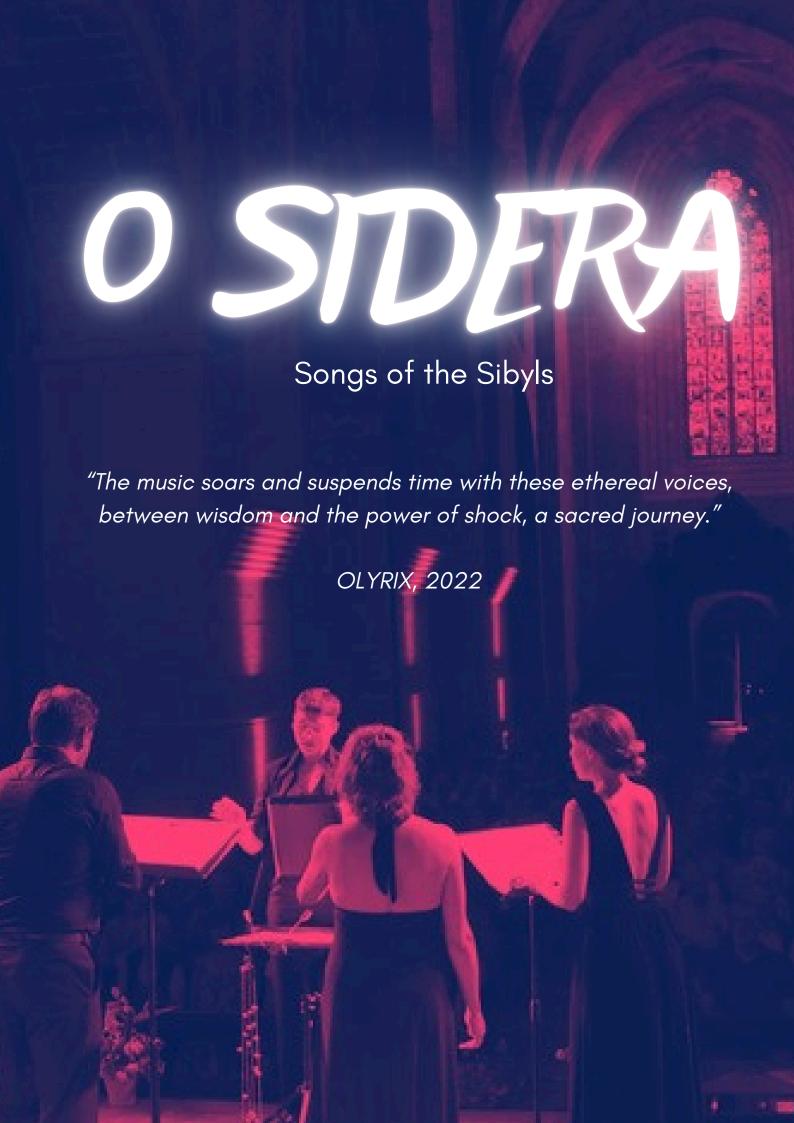
Sacred Motets by Heinrich Isaac | Georgian Orthodox Liturgy

Through the themes of enjoyment, mourning, and resurrection, the Irini Ensemble, creator of unexpected connections between East and West, brings together sacred works by Heinrich Isaac, a true Renaissance Bach, and excerpts from Georgian Orthodox liturgy.

In three acts, the Irini Ensemble, an a cappella octet, recounts an initiatory journey, between collapse and rebirth, following the Ariadne's thread of resilience.

Songs of the Sibyls

"A female version of the prophet, the figure of the Sybil inspired Roland de Lassus to compose a collection of songs of striking depth and sensitivity. Drawing on enigmatic texts announcing the coming of the Savior, language, distorted by Lassus or stretched by the Byzantine Asmatikon, fades away to give way to pure sensation. A new grammar is created, that of the encounter between music and the body, the singers' bodies with the body of the conducting gesture with the listeners' bodies, with the undertow of sound waves.

O Sidera is a shock, a rapture, which is first experienced and then explained.

The program is read when the singing stops, as if to seek a rational explanation for what one has just experienced.

Traveling between the Western Middle Ages, Byzantine heritage, and Eastern Christian tradition, the Irini Vocal Ensemble highlights the various figures of the Virgin and her cult, which finds a particular resonance in the Mediterranean.

The program features Greek, Lebanese, Syriac, and Cypriot Orthodox chants, excerpts from the Vermilion Book of Montserrat (14th century, Spain), and 13th-century Italian Lauds. From one shore and sound to the other of the "Mare Nostrum," the Irini Ensemble (whose name means "peace" in Greek) invites you to discover the diversity and musical richness of Marian worship in the Mediterranean.

Sackbuts ARTISTS IN DOUBLE CHOIR

At the dawn of the 17th century, between the Adriatic and the Black Sea, two geniuses revolutionized their time and ushered in a new era of music. Giovanni Gabrieli's sumptuous spatialized double-choir pieces are matched by the magnificence of the virtuoso Kalophonic singing of Konstantinos d'Aghialos and his contemporary Joasaph of Mount Athos, both bearing the exceptional title of "New Koukouzélis." These composers revolutionized their era and developed a language bursting with splendor that would go down in history. While Gabrieli marked the end of the Western Renaissance and the beginning of the Baroque era, d'Aghialos ushered in the Byzantine Renaissance, after the century of silence that followed the trauma of the Fall of Constantinople. POST TENEBRAS is a fireworks display bursting with life, offering the viewer the experience of the grandiose "made in" 1600.

BACK TO THE ROOTS

The Irini Ensemble reconnects with its origins by returning to the Marian repertoire of the Middle Ages with an all-female ensemble.

Far from a disembodied and diaphanous image, INVICTAE ("undefeated") summons the image of holy bacchantes. It is about putting flesh, movement and life back into the heart of the praise of the most iconic and transcultural divine feminine figure in the world.

The six female voices of the Ensemble Irini, directed by Lila Hajosi and set in motion by director Aïda Gabriels, sing without restraint, use their bodies as percussion, and create a language parallel to the music, which speaks in the flesh of the transcendental love for the "celestial Queen" and her "blessed entrails".
